Gerry: They have take-out but unfortunately not on a leash.
(A cat meows)
(Parody continues): They fry it real crisp in dough.

November 6 morning show segment

Gerry: Boy, wacky stuff in the paper today! Crazy!
 Jodi: No kidding.
 Wicksie: Crazy, crazy
 Gerry: Picked up the Calgary Sun and I find out, they have 40, 50 Asian women working here.
 Jodi: Uhmm
 Gerry: They got in apparently without any papers.
 Wicksie: What?
 Jodi: Uh huh...You know how?
 Gerry: How?
 Wicksie: Yeah.
 Jodi: Gerr?
 Gerry: They snuck'm in...for the old "rub'n tug"...Oh, it's, you see, what they, what they were doing, right, is they said they're bringing them to cook in the Panda restaurant in Edmonton.
 Jodi: Oh!
 Wicksie: And then brought them down Highway 2.
 Gerry: Right. After they cooked up the coyotes.
 Jodi: Put them in the old (whistle)

 Male: "Ash", what? What's that?
 Announcer: That's tonight at 8.
 Female voice: In my round inviting "ash".
 Male: Round...is something on fire? What...
 Female voice: No, my "ash", my supple round "ash". My J-Lo "ash".
 Male: Get that thing out of my face. What are you saying? I'm not paying for this.
 Female voice: Hit it, hit it. Hehehe, he so funny.
 Male: Where is the door?
 Gerry: Hit it!
 Announcer: Tonight on Singapore whore.
 Gerry: Hey, if you don't...
 Female voice: He's so bashful!
 Host: Yeah.
 Gerry: If you don't patronize these places, this stuff doesn't happen.
 Jodi: Uhummm
 Gerry: That's the key here.
 Wicksie: Although it sounds like they're getting aggressive with it, don't they?
 Gerry: Hit it.
 Jodi: Well. You go in because you've got an ache.
 Wicksie: Because you've gotta which?
 Jodi: An ache.
 Wicksie: A what? In your "ash"?
 Jodi: No, in your...Oh, forget it.

November 7 broadcast

Gerry: 7:16 now with Forbes and Friends and this sex slave thing.
 Jodi: Uhummm
 Gerry Firbes: (Whistles) Pretty sad stuff.
 Jodi: It is.
 Gerry: It's amazing how many Rub'N Tugs we do have in town.
 Wicksie: We do have a few.
 Jodi: Didn't know.
 Wicksie: There is one on 17 Avenue, right by the Boston Pizza, South-West.
 Gerry: There is one right there.
 Wicksie: I thought, I thought everybody knew about that one. I think it's called the Sunshine Studio.
 Gerry: Is that the one that got busted too?
 Wicksie: Yeah, I thought people knew about that.
 Gerry: Now, these are Thai people doing it to Thai people.
 Wicksie: Yeah.
 Gerry: They're bringing, they're bringing, uh, Thai agents who're sending people here to be sex-slaves, so it's really no better than what they have over in Thailand, in Bangkok.
